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The **Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders** (CSD) at Salzburg College's InterCultural Center (ICC) brings together specialization in theoretical and applied clinical linguistics with leading speech pathology research. Classes are small and taught by a distinguished faculty who are readily available to students. Two international tracks of degree programs are projected to be launched in conjunction with our partner university in 2017:

BA Communication Sciences and Disorders

The international track of the undergraduate program in **Communication Sciences and Disorders (BA)** focuses on communication and its impairments, both developmental and acquired. The program comprises the full range of speech, hearing and language diagnostics and intervention. Students have the opportunity to observe clinical practice at the Salzburg Speech Clinic (SSC).

MS Communication Sciences and Disorders

The international track of the graduate program in **Communication Sciences and Disorders (MS)** offers a special emphasis on morpho-phonological awareness in pre-school and school age children including early detection of children at risk for dyslexia and neuro-motor speech disorders (assessment and intervention). A major feature of the program is its highly individualized and culturalized approach as well as the opportunity of hands-on lab experience at the Salzburg Institute of Reading Research (SIRR).

Academy of Communication Sciences & Disorders (ACSD): Winter School, Workshops and SC Certificates

Over the last couple of years clinicians have begun to recognize the importance of culture and intercultural competence. This is especially relevant when it comes to assessment and intervention practices. Attention to cultural diversity and cutting edge research into culture x brain interactions has heightened the awareness to the manifold cultural challenges.

ICC Winter School (IWS)

Our 5-day Winter School participants take on challenging academics for university credit, while balancing educational and social activities. The specialised topic of the IWS is: **Multicultural and Multilingual Concerns in Communication Disorders** – it comprises the following three state-of-the-art graduate modules (3 credit hours total):
